### **NATIONAL SKIER DAYS UP SLIGHTLY**

The National Ski Areas Association (NSAA) has announced that U.S. resorts had 60.1 million skier visits last season -- an increase of 0.6 percent from the prior year and the second-best season in the history of the U.S. ski industry. Colorado had the largest share of the market with 20.4 percent of annual visits. California had 12.1 percent; Vermont, 7.1 percent; New York, 6.9 percent; Utah rounded out the top five states with 6.8 percent of the market. In addition, the seven Ski Lake Tahoe ski resorts are reporting an increase in skier visitation numbers to 3.6 million skier-days -- their second best total ever!

### **LEARN-TO-SKI MONTH TO CONTINUE IN 2012**

Learn To Ski and Snowboard Month is supported by ski resorts, retailers, and more than 4 million dollars worth of publicity with the slogan, "Humans were never meant to hibernate." That slogan seems to fit America's ski club mindset. The program's organizers are now actively soliciting ski clubs who will be listed on the program's website as local connections where people in your hometown can go to learn to ski (on your ski trips?) in January. #### **Women's Ski Jumping Approved for the 2014 Sochi Olympics**

LONDON – April 6, 2011 After an unsuccessful legal battle for inclusion at the 2010 Vancouver Olympics, women's ski jumping won its place on the program for the 2014 Winter Games in Sochi. The IOC twice rejected women's ski jumping for the 2010 Vancouver Olympics, saying the sport lacked enough elite competitors. Women jumpers took their case all the way to the Supreme Court of Canada, but failed to overturn the IOC decision. The women seemingly sealed their case at the Nordic world championships in Oslo in early March, when competitors jumped in heavy fog and strong wind. IOC board member Gerhard Heiberg of Norway said he was impressed by the level of competition and would recommend the event's inclusion to Rogge.

**Industry Impact Award to Shaun White.** The National Ski Areas Association (NSAA) presented its Industry Impact Award to snowboarder Shaun White. Last presented in 2009 to the Winter X Games, the Industry Impact Award recognizes significant contributions made to the ski and snowboard industry by an individual, business, or other entity. NSAA presented the award May 5 during its National Convention and Tradeshow at the La Costa Resort and Spa, Carlsbad, Calif. Lindsey Vonn was named in April 2011 by International Olympic Committee as the first ever Winter Youth Olympic Games Ambassador for the 2012 Winter Youth Olympic Games in Innsbruck Austria to be held January 13-22, 2012. Innsbruck 2012 is expected to attract over 1,000 top athletes aged 15-18 from about 70 countries competing in alpine (slalom and GS), cross country, freeskiing (skicross and halfpipe), Nordic combined, ski jumping and snowboarding (halfpipe and slopestyle). Athletes will also participate in a Culture and Education Programme (CEP) with activities providing guidance on topics such as Olympic values, the benefits of leading a healthy lifestyle, and the prevention of sports injuries.

Three FWSA athletic scholarship recipients competed in the U.S. Alpine Nationals at Winter Park, CO, March 21–April 3. Racing against a tough field that included many U.S. Ski Team members, **Haley Hanseler (sponsored by Mountain High Snowsports Club, an athletic scholarship partner)**, Lila Lapanja, and Morganne Murphy acquitted themselves with distinction by finishing in the top half in all events. Alexa Wehsenser, (sponsored by the San Diego Council, a scholarship partner) hit her stride with some of her best finishes this season by taking a 9th place in Slalom at the Western Region FIS Open, and 15th in Slalom and Giant Slalom (GS) at the Far West Finals. Dylan Murtha and Nicolo Monforte finished 12th and 13th respectively, in GS at the Far West Finals. **Jordan Schweitzer (sponsored by Skiyente Ski Club, a scholarship partner)** shined as she won the Super G and GS titles, as well as overall title, at the Northwest Cup race at Mission Ridge, WA. Linnea Baysinger and Cai Yamamoto took 11th and 2nd respectively in the Northwest Cup Super G events. Unfortunately, Jordan crashed during the Super G at the Western Region Elite FIS Spring Series and suffered a season ending concussion. This was typical of Jordan to pull out all the stops in both practice and competition. Fortunately, she'll be back in action next season. The focus of the athletic scholarship program now turns to the 2011-2012 season. CADS (Constant–force Articulated Dynamic Struts) is a spring loaded "bionic" suspension system that attaches to the skier in two places, the back of the ski boot and waist. This system has been proven to decrease leg muscle fatigue, knee strain and lower back strain all the while increasing edging power, snow contact, and control. Could this amazing device lead to an onslaught of 70-somethings entering mogul competitions alongside Johnny Mosley? [Editor's note: about twenty years ago a friend of mine who had bad knees from years of ballet dancing used this CADS setup and found that she could again ski all day and even ski moguls - so the concept has been around for a while!]

**SNOWSPORTS BUILDER AWARD RECIPIENTS** The Far West Ski Association (FWSA) annually names persons from the snowsports community who have made an

indelible positive impact on skiing. The Association honored three pioneers of snowsports at the Convention June 11 at the Pacific Palms Hotel in Industry Hills. The Snowsports Builder honorees for 2011 include:

1. Dave McCoy, the man who, from 1942, made Mammoth Mountain from scratch. Hundreds of thousands of skiers from the metro areas of Southern California learned to ski on Mammoth and it was and is a center for snowsports competition and training;

2. Norbert Olberz, a German immigrant who started with a small ski shop in La Canada and built Sports Chalet into a multi-state, multi-sports retailing business with travel services as well; and

3. Martha Perez, a travel professional who was hired initially in 1968 from volunteer status to manage the European charter flight programs and then the domestic travel programs of Far West Ski Association, a position she held for 10 years. She continues to serve a 43-year loyal customer base with Ski.com. Her career has spanned a number of travel agencies, including Sportours, and a 16–year partnership with Norbert Olberz, founder of Sports Chalet.
