2012 BACHELOR BLAST TRIP!!

Attention, Clubs! It's time to sign up for the 2012 Bachelor Blast trip to be held April 6-8, 2012! The basic trip price this year is \$210, and includes some extras: you'll get two nights of lodging in a Mt. Bachelor Village condo, two lift tickets to Mt. Bachelor, a fabulous lasagne lunch at Mt. Bachelor on Saturday, and a fantastic party on Saturday night! If you want to ski a third day you can get a discounted price, and an extra night's lodging can be arranged if you have a full condo.

This year we are staying in Ski House Loft condos (4 per condo) or luxury River Ridge condos (7-8 per condo; 3 BR w/queens, 3 BA; sofa sleeper) at Mt. Bachelor Village on Century Drive. Trip leader Linda McGavin will work with your club to put your members into condos that fit your needs, if

you wish to book a full condo. Only people who sign up in groups of 7-8 people will be put into the River Ridge condos. ALL guests have access to the Athletic Club of Bend!

Seniors and juniors will get extra discounts: Seniors 65-69 or Teens 13-18 can deduct \$15; Super Seniors 70+ or Youths 6-12 can deduct \$35; and children 5-12 can deduct \$45 from the basic trip price! Children are welcome on this trip as long as you fill a condo with the minimum number of people who agree to lodge together – we will not assign adults into a condo with children.

The bad news: **We only have 80 spots available** at these incredible prices – so you'll need to book early and contact trip leader Linda McGavin to work out the best condo(s) for your club members. Like other trips, individual club members can sign up directly and will be assigned lodging if they don't have a preference of roommates. So sign up early!

And the good news: Your club or group can still participate even after all of our basic trip spots are sold (or even if you would rather stay in a luxury home or different type of unit), because Mt. Bachelor Village is giving a special Bachelor Blast discount for ALL condos booked directly with them for this trip — mention Bachelor Blast if you call, or there will be a special code (announced later) if you book online. UNITED AIRLINES RETRACTS SKI LENGTH RULE

© They've done it again! This time United Airlines retracted their new rule about ski size before too many ski clubs even noticed it. The airline posted a ruling that skis can be no longer than 157 cm or 62 inches to avoid a \$100 surcharge. When Mike Hibbard of SportsAmerica pointed out to them that 157 cm was a kids' ski size, the airline checked out the facts and realized that they had meant to say 50 pounds was the limit (with no stated LENGTH limit). Problem avoided -- and the 157 cm rule has been deleted from United Airline's website.

Close to home in the Pacific Northwest: CNL Lifestyle Properties, Inc., of Orlando, Florida, has acquired **Stevens Pass Ski Resort** in Washington for \$20.5 million from Stevens Pass Mountain Resort, LLC, an affiliate of Mountain High Resort Associates, who will operate the area under a long-term lease agreement. No changes in operations are expected as a result of the change of ownership according to CNL Lifestyle Properties, which now owns and leases back 23 ski resorts throughout North America.
