events, so you will want to plan to come earlier!

Wednesday, April 4: First Comers Reception at the Deschutes Brewery in downtown Bend, with appetizers, a downtown Scavenger Hunt, and prizes.

Thursday, April 5: Welcome Reception at Seventh Mountain Resort, with a hot tub party, movie (Hot Dog the Movie, of course), appetizers, and live music.

Friday, April 6: participate in parties on the mountain during the day: the NW BBQ at the base of the Northwest Express chair; Pine Party where the lifts stay open from 4-7, and an aprés party with live music, beverages, and food. In downtown Bend there will be an Art Walk with unique artists, food and wine; and a Fireside Gathering at McMenamins.

Saturday April 7 is "Hot Dog Day" on the mountain - you'll get to watch a Freestyle Legends Ski Show and participate (or watch) in a Hot Dog Chinese Downhill Race at the end of the ski day, with a costume contest! Bachelor Blast participants will enjoy a lasagne buffet lunch at noon.

Saturday evening there will be a Hot Dog Finale Party at GoodLife Brewing, with gourmet hot dogs and brews (one apiece furnished with your entry), a Hot Dog the Movie Look-Alike Contest, Hot Dog courtyard games, live music, and the Video Contest premiere.

Sunday April 8 is Easter, with an Easter Egg Hunt for the children and a Keg Hunt for adults!

You get to participate in <u>ALL</u> of these events for your basic trip price of \$210, which also includes two nights of lodging in a Mt. Bachelor Village condo, a 2-out-of-3 day lift ticket to Mt. Bachelor, the lasagne lunch at Mt. Bachelor on Saturday, and the party on Saturday night! If you want to ski

extra days you can get a discounted price (3 out of 5 days, or more), and one or two extra nights lodging can be arranged if you have a full condo.

We are staying at Mt. Bachelor Village on Century Drive in Ski House Loft condos (4 per condo) or luxury River Ridge condos (7-8 per condo; 3 BR w/queens, 3 BA; sofa sleeper). Trip leader Linda McGavin will work with your club to put your members into condos that fit your needs, if you wish to book a full condo. Only people who sign up in groups of 7-8 people will be put into the River Ridge condos. ALL guests have access to the Athletic Club of Bend!

Seniors and juniors will get extra discounts: Seniors 65-69 or Teens 13-18 pay \$195; Super Seniors 70+ pay \$175; and Youths 6-12 pay only \$165! Children are welcome on this trip as long as you fill a condo with the minimum number of people who agree to lodge together – we will not assign unrelated adults into a condo with children. (Children are included in the Saturday night Hot Dog party and get a hot dog and soft drink.)

The bad news: We only have 80 spots available at these incredible prices – so you'll need to book early and contact trip leader Linda McGavin to work out the best condo(s) for your club members. Like other trips, individual club members can sign up directly and will be assigned lodging if they don't have a preference of roommates. So sign up early!

And the good news: Your club or group can still participate even after all of our basic trip spots are sold (or even if you would rather stay in a luxury home or different type of unit), because Mt. Bachelor Village is giving a special Bachelor Blast discount for ALL condos booked directly with them for this trip — mention Bachelor Blast if you call, or there will be a special code if you book online. An amenity package is available for those booking other Mt. Bachelor Village properties, or those who own their own lodging in Bend, starting at \$125 for 2 lift tickets, lunch, all the above activities, and the party on Saturday night, again with further discounts for seniors and juniors! Ask for a special signup form for this option.

More good news - you can pay for this trip with your Visa or Mastercard! You will need to contact the Council treasurer, Marcia Brighton, at 360-721-1300 to use one of these two credit cards. Leave a message and Marcia will call you back when she is able to process the card online.

## PACRAT INFORMATION:

PACRAT has held its first race January 29, and the results are posted on the PACRAT website: www.pacrats.org. Course Director Dale Parshall reports: "Well, we started dry and got most of the day in before the heavy stuff hit. The course held up great thanks to everyone's efforts with course maintenance. A few slippers went through the finish which caused a rerun for two, so please watch for that. We had a strong start to the season with 183 racers showing up for our first race. It's close at the top with 9 teams within 17 points of the lead. Old standbys Racy Brats and Rattitudes are one and two with 48 and 47 points, respectively, and Ragnar's Rangers made a strong showing with 41 points, tied for third with Ruttin' Rats. Don't be discouraged if your team is not near the top to start, as we have seen huge point swings in the past, especially if your team has full participation. We have six boarders this year and we'll score them with the 10% discount as prescribed by NASTAR. As for individuals, there's strong competition for fastest man and woman on the hill with Peter Dodd topping the men this race and Colleen Walter topping the ladies. Our next scheduled race is at Meadows February 12, the day after Skiyente's King Winter celebration at Charlie's (see your favorite Skiyente for tickets).

Check with your favorite Schnee or Skiyente if you are interested in a Masters race March 3-4 at Ski Bowl.
