Wednesday, April 4: **First Comers Reception** at the Deschutes Brewery in downtown Bend, with appetizers, a downtown **Scavenger Hunt**, and prizes.

Thursday, April 5: **Welcome Reception** at Seventh Mountain Resort, with a **hot tub party**, movie (Hot Dog the Movie, of course), appetizers, and live music.

Friday, April 6: participate in parties on the mountain during the day: the **NW BBQ** at the base of the Northwest Express chair; **Pine Party** where the lifts stay open from 4-7, and an après party with live music, beverages, and food. In downtown Bend there will be an **Art Walk** with unique artists, food and wine; and a **Fireside Gathering at McMenamins**.

Saturday April 7 is **"Hot Dog Day"** on the mountain - you'll get to watch a **Freestyle Legends Ski Show** and participate (or watch) in a **Hot Dog Chinese Downhill Race** at the end of the ski day, with a **costume contest!** Bachelor Blast participants will enjoy a lasagne buffet lunch at noon.

Saturday evening there will be a **Hot Dog Finale Party** at GoodLife Brewing, with gourmet hot dogs and brews (one apiece furnished with your entry), a **Hot Dog the Movie Look-Alike Contest**, Hot Dog courtyard games, live music, and the Video Contest premiere.

We are staying at Mt. Bachelor Village on Century Drive in Ski House Loft condos (4 per condo) or luxury River Ridge condos (7-8 per condo; 3 BR w/queens, 3 BA; sofa sleeper). Trip leader Linda McGavin will work with your club to put your members into condos that fit your needs, if you wish to book a full condo. Only people who sign up in groups of 7-8 people (or who are willing to pay extra for fewer people in the unit) will be put into the River Ridge condos. ALL guests have access to the Athletic Club of Bend!

Seniors and juniors will get extra discounts: Seniors 65-69

or Teens 13-18 pay \$195; Super Seniors 70+ pay \$175; and Youths 6-12 pay only \$165! Children are welcome on this trip as long as you fill a condo with the minimum number of people who agree to lodge together – we will not assign unrelated adults into a condo with children. (Children are included in the Saturday night Hot Dog party and get a hot dog and soft drink.)

PACRAT INFORMATION:

PACRAT has now held 3 races, and the results are posted on the PACRAT website: www.pacrats.org. Course Director Dale Parshall reports about the third race: "The rain turned to snow in time to give us a solid base without too much new stuff to push out of the course. The crew set a fast course and it held up reasonably well given the conditions. Our efforts with course maintenance continue to pay off. We a good turnout with 178 racers showing up. It remains close at the top with 6 teams within 25 points of the lead. The top two teams remained unchanged (Rattitudes 1st and Kiss My Wax 2nd) with Ruttin' Rats making a big jump from 13th to 3rd, scoring 71 points! Another big mover was Frosted Flakes, scoring 67 points to move from 18th to 10th. That continues the mantra that if your team is not near the top you can see huge point swings in one race, especially if your team has full participation. Peter Dodd reclaimed fastest man honors after a late bobble by Ken Park, and newcomer Christina Post edged Barb Pressentin for top woman for the second race in a row. Our final two races are on back-to-back weekends March 25 and April 1. Plus there is a NASTAR Open race at Ski Bowl on March 24 if you want

to get some practice in. That race will cost \$10 for two runs plus \$5 each additional run."

Downhill Race March 24, Oyster Feed March 31, and Toyota Ski Free Week April 2-8. **Attention Mountain Bikers:** October 6, 2012 will be the Tour De Rock and Rough Ride 4000' Bike Ride fundraisers! Proceeds go to support the 49° North Ski Patrol (a nonprofit organization) for the procurement of medical supplies and equipment, education and training, and radios and toboggans for use in safety and first aid on the mountain. The mountain course will be a climb up through Sunrise Basin on unpaved roads, then a traverse across the face of the mountain, and finally a fun downhill run back to the lodge. There are many great view points, clean mountain air, refreshments, and support services along the way. There will also be an extended and more advanced course, to the summit, for those who are up for a greater challenge.

For the ultimate challenge, Rough Ride 4000', riders can start in Chewelah at the City Park and ride on pavement to the 49° North Mountain Lodge and from there continue on the unpaved routes described above.

The special half price ski day for NWSCC members at **Crystal Mountain** will be **March 25, 2012!** Just show your NWSCC membership card at the ticket windows to score a ticket for \$33, with an optional gondola upgrade for \$8! If your club has a group who wants to ski Saturday, special group rates will be offered. Contact Crystal for info.

Schweitzer is hosting the **4th annual 24 hours for Hank**, which is a fundraising team relay for skiers, telemark skiers, and snowboarders beginning on Friday March 30th and ending on Saturday, March 31. Three intermediate runs will be used over the course of 24 hours. Teams will ski and ride for prizes, bragging rights and most importantly fundraising for Cystinosis research and Hank's future. Hood Meadows in Oregon, and Crystal Mountain, Mount Rainier, Stevens Pass and Snoqualmie in Washington. Skiing Heritage will be honoring the Mahre brothers, K2 Ski & Snowboard Company, and Ski Magazine (which started in Seattle 75 years ago!!). Date for the event is April 8-15, 2012. The finale will take place on Saturday, April 14th in Seattle, Washington with the induction of several new members into the U.S. Ski and Snowboard Hall of Fame, including: Joe Pack (2002 Olympic silver medalist, 3 World Cup wins, 12 World Cup podiums, 2 World Championship bronze medals), Eva Twardokens (1985 World Championship bronze medalist, 3 World Cup podiums), Nick Badami (resort builder - Alpine Meadows, CA; Park City, UT; Powdr Corp), Phil Gravink (resort builder - Peak N Peek, NY; Gore Mountain, NY; Loon Mountain, NH); Mason Beekley (ski historian, International Skiing History Association founder), Dick Dorworth (speed skier and author), Harry Leonard (ski show pioneer), Tyler Palmer (2 World Cup wins, 4 World Cup podiums and pro ski racer).
