PACRAT INFORMATION:

The Rat Attack was held April 13, 2012, at The Refectory, and the winning teams for the year were announced. Here's the report from Dale Parshall:

I guess the weather gods didn't want us to have a spring race, so we plowed through a wintery day to finish up the

season. The race crew set a fast course and there were some fast times.

Ruttin' Rats avoided its usual last race swoon and added 44 points to their total (remember we score 4 out of 5 races) to pull away from the field and hold onto the title they won last year. Chilled Brewskis put on a late charge to move from 3rd to 2nd, edging Rat Racers by three points and Rattitudes by 11 points. Kiss My Wax rounded out the top five, and Tasmanian Ski Devils added 56 points to move from 13th to 6th.

King and Queen Rat are awards to racers who show the most consistent and greatest improvement over the course of the season. This year's King Rat is Alan Bean (Lab Rats), who improved his handicap every race and showed an overall improvement of 45%. Queen Rat is Jeanne Nyquist (Chilled Brewskis), who showed improvement every race and had an overall improvement of 29%. For race 5, Peter Dodd claimed the last "fastest man on the hil" I title, giving him three for the year. On the ladies side, Christina Post claimed her fourth "fastest woman on the hill" title of the year.

Full details are on the PACRAT website, including Dale's annual statistics. The correlation between participation and final team standings is very clear. Dale says PACRAT is getting better with the timing and seems to have the group times worked out, so hopefully everyone is happy with how the race day schedule is working. Feel free to give the board suggestions to make things better. See you next year.

FWSA Scholarship Recipients Shine! It is gratifying to see so many junior athletes sponsored by FWSA excel in ski racing. Incline's Lila Lapanja, a three-time scholarship recipient and 2011 appointee to the U.S. Ski Team (USST),

took 3rd in the junior division slalom and a 1st in the combined. Rose Caston, from the Park City Ski Team, scored three top 5 finishes, including bronze medal in giant slalom, at the Western Region Elite Series at Mission Ridge, WA (7-9 April). Forest Peterson, sponsored by Castro Valley Ski Club and a USST member, had two top 10 finishes at the Colorado Surefoot Ski Club races in Breckenridge, CO. Jordan Schweitzer (sponsored by Skivente Ski Club) scored two second places in Super G and slalom at the Eigenvector NW Cup at Mission Ridge, WA, on March 30 & 31. She also had a top 5 finish at the Elite Series downhill at Mt. Bachelor on 15 April. Linnea Baysinger took 5th and Ali Gunesch (sponsored by Bergfreunde Ski Club) took 8th in the slalom at the Eigenvector NW Cup. Garret Driller from Squaw Valley took 1st place in GS and Dylan Brooks from Sugar Bowl finished in the top 10 in both slalom and giant slalom at the Western Region FIS Open at Sugar Bowl, CA (March 9-10). Among the ladies, Hannah Johnson and Ali Gunesch finished in the top 10 in giant slalom. From the NATIONAL SKI CLUB NEWS:

NEW YEAR-ROUND SKI AREA FOR B.C.?

The British Columbia government has approved development of the Jumbo Glacier Alpine Resort, which could become the country's first year-round, glacier-based ski resort, barring environmental appeal delays. The resort will be located in the Purcell Mountains 40 miles west of Invermere, B.C., and not far from Panorama resort. The \$1 billion development was initially proposed in the 1990's. Since then, the project had passed all necessary regulatory and environmental hurdles. At build-out, Jumbo Glacier will boast up to 23 lifts, a gondola, and more than 6,000 condos. That would make it about one-third the size of Panorama. The first phase will include a gondola and T-bar.
