The **Oregon Cancer Ski Out** is a one-of-a-kind fundraising event that brings together skiers and snowboarders in teams of four to raise funds for the fight against cancer. This year the Oregon Cancer Ski Out returns with big changes, moving to a one-day race event on Sunday March 13th. Teams will be made up of 4 skiers and the team entry will only be \$795. The race will be 2 runs in the morning and 2 in the afternoon and back to the same formula as past years, with the winning teams having the most consistent race times. ### Excerpts from Far West News Flash JANUARY 2022 Far West Ski Association

**U.S. SKI & SNOWBOARD HALL OF FAME:** The Hall of Fame has announced its schedules and events for the 2022 Induction of this year's inductees. Honorees: *Sherman Poppen, Brian Fairbanks, Holly Flanders, Seth Wescott and Howard Peterson* will be inducted at **Bretton Woods** Omni Mount Washington on Saturday, March 5, 2022, with activities and events throughout the days and evenings of March 3-5, 2022. Honorees at **Sun Valley** are: *Scott Brooksbank, Bobbie Burns, Art Clay & Ben Finley, Kit Deslaurier, Jim Niehues, Alison Owen, Kristean Porter, Jimmy Spillane, Greg Stump and Hank Tauber.* Activities and events will be held March 23-27, with the induction planned for Saturday night, March 26th. The *Spider Sabich Celebration* is planned for Friday, April 8, 2022, in **Snowmass Village**. A free showing of the film "*Spider Lives*" will be held in **all** locations.

**U.S. PASSPORTS TO SOON BE RENEWABLE ONLINE:** The process to renew your passport is a headache, to be sure. That may soon become an easier process. As part of President Biden's executive order on transforming federal customer experience and service delivery to rebuild trust in government, the Secretary of State will be tasked with creating a new online renewal system "that does not require any physical documents to be mailed." While this does bring about worries of submitting personal details—especially for an official form of identity—over the internet, experts agree that shouldn't be a huge concern. Many of us shop online, bank online, and manage personal information online already. People need to be cautious that they don't use fraudulent sites to apply—they should carefully check the URL or application link to ensure they are dealing with the State Department, and not an imposter. No specific timeline was given for the launch of this program. White House press secretary Jen Psaki said in a briefing that it's going to take six to 12 months for the system to get rolling, but explained that "it's a priority for agencies," with the only hurdle being the time it takes to get it implemented.
