Who votes in PACRAT Elections?

PACRAT bylaws provide that each club is allocated a certain number of points. The clubs must decide on who gets to vote for the club. Usually it is the Team Captains, but in cases where there are more teams than votes available, only the number of votes designated for that club may be cast. ALL team captains CAN be there to caucus, but your club can only cast the proper number of votes.

price of \$1,115 pp/do includes airport transfers from Bonaire International Airport; 7 nights' lodging at the Plaza Beach Resort Bonaire in a Junior Laguna Suite; all meals; all drinks including



alcohol; use of paddle boards, kayaks & catamarans and frequent daytime activities; 6 days of 2-tank boat dives and unlimited shore diving; and MORE! Non-divers pay \$836 pp/do. You'll have time to explore and experience the local culture, or simply relax and enjoy the resort. Limited group air is available on Delta Airlines RT from Los Angeles to Bonaire; estimated at \$725 per person.

Far West Ski Week 2016: Telluride Ski Resort is the location for the Far West Ski Week trip January 30-February 6, 2016. \$100 deposits are now being accepted for this trip (fully refundable until June 30)! NWSCC will have two very fine choices for lodging, both ski in/ski out: condos at Bear Creek Lodge, or hotel rooms at The Peaks Resort. The package price for the hotel will be \$1,430 pp/do; for 2 bedroom condos the price will be \$1,330 pp/do; and for either 3 or 4 bedroom condos the price will be \$1,200! These prices are for land only (no air or transfers), but include 7 nights' lodging, Welcome Party,

Pub Crawl, Council Night Dinner, Mountain Picnic (not accessible to non-skiers, due to location), Après Ski Party, Races, a Banquet with dancing, and 6 of 7 day Lift Ticket (no senior discount). Excerpts from the NATIONAL SKI CLUB NEWS: SNOWMASS TO REPLACE HIGH ALPINE LIFT WITH \$8

MILLION QUAD: Aspen Skiing Company will replace and realign the High Alpine lift on Snowmass. The estimated cost of this project is nearly \$8 million. The new High speed quad has a ride time of 5.6 minutes, down from an 11 minute ride on the old chairlift. Construction will begin this summer and the new lift and improvements will debut for the 2015-16 ski season.

JACKSON HOLE ADDING NEW HIGH SPEED QUAD

LIFT: A new high speed quad lift is going up in Jackson Hole, Wyoming for the 2015-16 season, providing advanced and expert skiers access to an area called Granite which has so far been accessible only via hiking. The reason it's a topic of conversation now is because of how dramatically it will shift how people approach some of the best—and potentially dangerous—backcountry terrain in North America. When it starts spinning next year, the chair will deposit skiers less than a hundred feet away from the resort's northern boundary. This radical terrain—known as Granite Canyon—lies out of bounds within Grand Teton National Park. Current access is through a few different bootpacks and a series of backcountry gates at the resort.


