GUEST SPEAKERS AT SEPTEMBER MEETING:

Jared Montague continued his tradition of keeping us updated about Brundage Mountain Resort in Idaho at our September meeting. Brundage opened in 1961, and is located 100 miles north of Boise and only 8 miles from McCall, Idaho, with fabulous views of Payette Lake and surrounding mountain ranges. It is known for "the best snow in Idaho" due to its location in the Northern Rockies, and has great slopes, top notch grooming, quality skiing, and an unbelievable lack of crowds! The Bluebird high speed quad takes you up 1,800' to enjoy a wide variety of runs, including gladed tree skiing. Two snowcats operate on a 17,000 acre permit area that includes 3 separate mountains, at a cost for a full day of only \$239 plus tax per person, including powder skis, lunch, and guided skiing! For \$1,600 per day (plus tax), you can book the entire snowcat for up to 10 skiers on weekdays; \$1,900 plus tax on weekends or holidays. The McCall area also has 50 k of cross country skiing. While there is no on-mountain lodging, Brundage partners with the Shore Lodge and other lodging in McCall for packages. For individual discounted skiing, look at their "Select" Cards, available at local retailers in Boise and online. Special rates are also available for groups of 10 or more people. Clubs take note that with its small staff, Brundage can be VERY flexible in offering you the best service with the least notice, and will always show you a big welcome! You can expect free guided tours of the area as well! Brundage will be at the Ski Fever shows in Seattle (Oct 26-28) and Portland (Nov 2-4), so please come visit their booth to take advantage of some great show specials. Check them out at www.brundage.com, and see attached flier.

Dave Tragethon and Katie Kadlub updated us on the latest at Mt. Hood Meadows. Of course the biggest news is the installation of new RFID gates at every lift for the upcoming season! Instead of having to pull out your ticket or pass for manual scanning, your pass or ticket can be inside your pocket and the gates will automatically open up as you pass - making the lines move far faster! In addition, you will be able to view online where you skied each day and how many vertical feet you skied. (I know many people who will like that feature!). Everyone will need new season passes this year with the RFID chip, and will need a new picture taken. There will be many opportunities for picture taking, including at the Mt. Hood Meadows office in the Pearl, at REI stores (certain evenings at certain stores), and the ski shows. These new passes will be very secure, and cannot be shared, as employees with receivers will be able to see your picture come up as you go through the gates.

Also new this year is a "Meadows Club Card" that anyone can purchase. They will pay \$99 for this direct to lift "pay as

you go" pass which will automatically charge your credit card when you first pass through the RFID gates. The 1st and 5th days are FREE, and then every 5th day is free. In between, your card will be charged \$79 for "peak" days (saving \$10), or \$59 for "off peak" days (saving \$15).

Meadows is encouraging you to park and ride on peak days, when the parking lots sometimes fill up by 10 am and they have to turn people away! Season passholders can ride the bus for \$20 and not have to worry about parking! Those who need lift tickets can ride the bus AND get a peak day ticket for the total price of \$89 (the same price as a peak ticket!). The buses will leave from three locations in Portland, and in case of Highway 26 being slow or blocked, will be able to head back to Portland through Hood River and not be stuck in traffic for hours.

Special Ski Fair Offer from Mt. Hood Meadows: First, you can still get your season pass at the pre-season price for one additional day - and get your picture taken. Second, you can purchase a 10-time pass good any day (including peak days) for \$379 instead of \$419. Best yet, this deal will be good for NWSCC club members online all season long! You will be required to show your NWSCC membership card before picking up your pass.

There is just so much happening at Meadows that you have to check out their website online at www.skihood.com and to check out the attached flier for all kinds of special deals!

Nancy Chinn, Executive Director of the Oregon Cancer Ski Out, spoke about next year's event, which will be held March 10-11, 2013, at Mt. Hood Meadows. This will be the 25th year, and OCSO has set a high goal of reaching a grand total of \$1 million in funds raised over that period. The event is a uniquely formatted (and FUN!) two day ski race at Mt. Hood Meadows, for up to 35 five-member teams made up of skiers and boarders of all ages and all levels. The format rewards teams for consistency, rather than speed. Of the dollars raised, a whopping 90% of the monies actually go to worthy causes working on the forefront of this battle. The money is given without any strings as to its use, and it has helped the OHSU Knight Cancer Institute to do innovative cancer research that might not otherwise be funded; to Providence-Willamette Falls Hospice and Hospice of the Gorge; and to Candlelighters (for children with cancer and their families). Thanks to their generous sponsors and dedicated race participants, guests and volunteers, over \$708,000 has been raised for beneficiaries since 1989. This means that this year's event needs to raise almost \$300,000. Teams are urged to dedicate their fundraising efforts in honor of someone in their lives who has personally been touched by cancer. The volunteers have two of their own who are currently in treatment for cancer, Shirley and Casino Dealer Mike. So the "volunteer team" will be raising money in honor of those two. One long time skiing participant, Don McPherson, recently died of brain cancer this last month, and we hope a team will be raising funds in his honor. Please consider forming a team, joining a team, volunteering, or just donating to help this worthy cause! Go to www.cancerskiout.org to learn more.

New NWSCC Safety Director Sylvia Orefice would like to come to your club and talk about safety, being in shape, the importance of wearing a helmet, and the little known fact that helmets are not good indefinitely, even if you have not taken a fall where the helmet hit sharply. Many state laws require children to wear helmets, and *major* improvements have been made in helmet design through the years. Sylvia will try to have a vendor available at Ski Fair to sell helmets at special prices! Sylvia may arrange for special guest speakers at future NWSCC meetings, including Life Flight or a physical therapist.
