NORTHWEST SKI CHALLENGE:

NORTHWEST SNOWSPORTS ADVOCATES NEWS:

Mt. Ashland needs YOUR help - financially this time. Mt. Ashland received a ruling this summer allowing it to proceed with the construction of two ski lifts, new runs, and expanding the parking area, but first it needs to raise money to finance the improvements. As a nonprofit, a successful capital campaign is essential to the success of the project.

Mt. Ashland has budgeted \$150,000 in contributed support to augment operational revenue. Realizing that goal will assist the ski area in mitigating rising annual costs of doing business. Mt. Ashland began a fundraising campaign in June with the goal of raising \$350,000 to help the ski area recover from its operational loss during the 2011-12 season, cover current debt, and add a little padding to a reserve fund. Since June they have raised \$243,000 in donations and commitments, but they have \$57,000 to go. Please consider including Mt. Ashland in your year-end giving this year! Timberline Ski Area has just received approval from the Forest Service for a lift-assisted mountain biking "skills park" on Mt. Hood. The project's 17 miles of trails would cover much of the lower ski slopes below the tree line, with the bikers pedaling along ski runs and through nearby forest patches from July through October. Timberline would install bike carriers on the Jeff Flood chairlift, and the trails would have a full time maintenance crew. The Forest Service

approved the bike park after two years of review which included an environmental assessment and 1,200 public comments, including letters in support from NWSCC.

STEVE COXEN WINS AWARD

The Gene Landsmann Gemütlichkeit Award is given each year to a Ski Oregon member who exemplifies the spirit of Gene Landsmann (former Mt. Ashland manager). That is, an ambassador of skiing who embodies Gemütlichkeit–a German concept of warmth, cheerfulness and willingness to spend quality time.

This year's award goes to Steve Coxen. A Ski Oregon member since 1988, Steve personifies every element of Gemütlichkeit. When he was president of Bergfreunde Ski Club, he expanded his club's subsidized night skiing at Mt. Hood Skibowl to offer free lessons for new skiers, free recreational racing in PACRAT, and other ski opportunities at Timberline and Mt. Hood Meadows.

Steve has served as president of both Northwest Ski Club Council and Far West Ski Association. When he held those positions he promoted the wonderful attributes of Oregon skiing at every opportunity, including National Ski Council Federation annual meetings. In 2006 Steve encouraged skiers to try all Oregon ski areas by organizing the first Oregon Ski Challenge, a NWSCC event open to all skiers and snowboarders. Prizes and awards were given to participants who could attest to skiing at all Oregon ski areas.

In 2003, Steve was concerned about the passionate, but silent and uninformed, legions of skiers and snowboarders in the Pacific Northwest, and founded Northwest Snowsports Advocates—an online organization founded specifically to inform and engage Northwest skiers on public issues related to ski area development, the environment, safety, and highway planning. He serves as the driving force behind the Advocates by maintaining an internet presence at www.nwskiers.org, on Facebook, and through his blog.

Steve, who has been honored with numerous ski club and council awards, has helped Ski Oregon achieve the bottom line–growing skier visits in Oregon.

FROM FWSA NEWS:

Snow Guarantees: It appears that many skiers are playing it safe this year and waiting to see where the snow will fall before booking winter trips. To counteract this trend towards later bookings, a number of ski resorts are introducing fantastic early booking discounts, many of which center upon some type of "Snow Guarantee." They are saying, "We know you're a bit gun-shy after last winter, but book now because we'll have snow. If not, we'll let you cancel, switch your dates or somehow make it right." Winter Park and Mammoth Mountain are two of those offering up Snow Guarantees. Check their websites to see what they can offer you.

Customized Airline Pricing: Airlines are experimenting with a new way to sell tickets and personalize prices to win back customers from comparison websites such as Travelocity and Orbitz. The International Air Transport Association, which represents airlines globally, is promoting the experiment to start next year as a way to customize ticket pricing, including fees for luggage and seat assignments. Airlines would ask shoppers for personal information, including membership in frequent-flier programs, travel history or use of a credit card, as they do at a specific airline site. They would then tailor a ticket price for each passenger, including pricing items such as meals, extra legroom, or expedited boarding. The experiment is scheduled to begin early next year and potentially be adopted by 2016.

Member Corner: As a member of Far West, you are privy to a number of wonderful perks which can be found on our website. Click on "Member Corner" and scroll down to "Benefits" to check out the numerous discounts you can receive on ski rentals, transportation to Park City, lodging in Bend, and scores of other goodies. NEW this year are The Powder House, in Bend, Oregon, providing members a 10% discount off rentals and retail merchandise; Park City Peaks Hotel in Park City; and the Phoenix Inn & Suites in Bend, Oregon. Last month, I listed a couple of our newest lodging partners, providing some great discounts to Far West members during their travels over the next year. Since then, I have gotten together with Go Alpine, the main transportation company between Denver or Hayden airports and Steamboat. Go Alpine is offering a 15%

discount on their shuttle service. If your travels are taking you to Steamboat this coming season, check them out. The benefits are updated often, so keep checking to see what's new!

Another benefit we have available is through **Legal Shield**. Legal Shield features would be: representation on traffic violations in any state, accident representation in any state (whether auto or on the slopes), insurance disputes and claim problems, billing disputes, luggage lost by airlines, lost wallet and ID information with legal and identity theft restoration support, and 24 emergency card for accusation of identity theft or Miranda rights issues. It covers the entire family (kids up to 21 or 23 if in college full-time) and every specialty of law for a small monthly fee of \$17 to \$28 month. The legal network is composed of top ranking AV-rated law firms across the nation with availability of over 2,000 attorneys, with same day access.

RELIEF FUND FOR VICTIMS OF HURRICANE SANDY

Eastern Winter Sports Reps Association (EWSRA) has established a fund through the organization Waves for Water to help colleagues who were severely affected by Hurricane Sandy in the Mid-Atlantic. Many association members, their families, and the retail accounts that they serve, were wiped out by Hurricane Sandy, losing their homes and businesses in New York and New Jersey. The Waves for Water organization typically focuses on providing clean water to those who need it in disaster relief situations. Efforts generally are targeted in areas outside the U.S. In the aftermath of Sandy, the organization is providing clean water and also is addressing the initial survival needs from first responder assistance to rubble removal and ultimately the rebuilding of our surf and snow communities.

Red Mountain Adds Almost 1,000 Acres: Red Mountain Resort on the famous Powder Highway near Rossland, British Columbia, has begun their long-planned development of Grey Mountain. The two-year expansion will add 997 acres to their current 1,685 acres. The new ski terrain will be open this season using snowcats to shuttle skiers up the mountain for \$10 per run, but a quad chairlift will access the new terrain for the 2013-2014 ski season. Red's Granite Mountain has always been known for world-class tree skiing with incredible steeps, and the new Grey Mountain expansion will open up mostly intermediate terrain to

balance the terrain availability. Grey, like Granite Mountain, is volcano-shaped, which allows for 360-degree skiing around the peak from a single lift.

Park City Resorts Quick Start Vacation Program Renewed: Three of Park City, Utah's, resorts will offer their Quick Start Vacation again this year. Under the program, you can turn your airline boarding pass into a same-day lift ticket for Deer Valley Resort, Canyons Resort, or Park City Mountain Resort.
