Meadows PDX is now open for the 2020-2021 season! Location is 1639 N.W. Northrup, Portland and operates Thursdays through Sundays from 9:30 AM to 5:30 PM, offering such amenities and items as pass purchases and fulfillment, Sno-Park permits (coming soon!), gift cards, lost and found pickup, a great selection of logo wear and gifts, as well as answers to your questions about lessons, rentals, and more. We recently caught up with Meadows PDX Manager Brooke Thomas for a video interview to discuss what's new at our Portland location for this fall, which you can view on our blog.

Make sure you're all set for opening day at Meadows and get your Season Pass! If you had a pass last season, you can renew it here. New to Meadows or didn't have a pass during the 2019-20 season? We

have new Value Passes and Night Passes available for purchase, as well as a limited number of All Access Passes. Get your pass, get your wax, and get ready for snow! The pass prices will not go up until after November 8.

With fall fast approaching, thoughts are turning to the 2020-2021 winter recreation season and what it will look like. We've been visualizing since March what those scenarios might be, and today, we released our winter operations plan, which you can read on our blog. We encourage you to read the post in its entirety, and we plan on adding additional information as we get closer to the start of the season. But if you're short on time, here are some key points:

- First and foremost, we do plan on opening for the 2020-2021 winter recreation season
- The health and safety of our team and guests continues to be our top priority, and the COVID-19 pandemic means we all have to take extra precautions so we can enjoy our time on the mountain. That means the wearing of face masks is required for both team members and guests. We've also re-engineered our operations to achieve social distancing, upgraded our air filtration system, and are continuing to follow enhanced sanitization procedures
- Managing visitation via lift access will be key to having a successful season. That means many items will have to be purchased online in advance, such as lift tickets, lessons, equipment rentals, etc. All Access Pass holders will not need to make reservations in order to ski or ride, but we are limiting the number of NEW (not renewing) All Access Pass purchases this season

Again, please read the blog post for additional information. Stay well, stay safe, and we can't wait to see you on the mountain for Meadows' 53rd season.

Cooper Spur Mountain Resort is a great basecamp for your Mt. WHO & WHAT'S NEW FOR 2020

HAPPY BIRTHDAY FAR WEST: Far West Ski Association turned 90 years old on October 7, 2020. The life and times of Far West has been put together in a beautiful commemorative publication, which will soon be available to those interested in reading how it all began. Many people have crossed the threshold of Far West Ski Association in these past 90 years, from snowsports partners, Olympians, mountain-climbers, Tenth Mountain Division members, adaptive skiers and climbers, Forest Service Representatives, educational and leadership mentors, and many more. The organization provides a chance for the members to get together for travel opportunities, both domestically, and through our wonderful International travel program. Ski trips, dive trips, and adventure trips abound. The annual Convention allows friends to gather for that oncea-year reunion to catch up with each other. The clubs and councils of FWSA contribute to the communities which they serve through charitable giving and community events. They look toward the future with racing scholarships awarded each year to promising young athletes, and recognize those who are involved in ski history, environmental safety and skier safety, both on and off the mountain. Congratulations to an organization that is well respected, and well revered across the country by our fellow ski chapters.

U.S. SKI AND BOARD HALL OF FAME ANNOUNCEMENT: Eight ski and snow board athletes and sport builders were recently named to the 2020 US Ski and Board Hall of Fame. The eight include: the late Howard Peterson, leader and visionary of the U.S. Ski Team; Holly Flanders, Olympic downhill racer; ski area mastermind, Brian Frank; two-time Olympic Champion snowboarder Seth Wescott; long-time international ski federation and U.S. Ski Team leader, Hank Tauber; FIS Cross Country World Cup winner, Alison Owen; inventor of the THE ski, Bobby Burns; and U.S. Ski Team Freestyle Aerialist, Kristean Porter.

NEWS FROM U.S. AIRLINE COMPANIES: A number of U.S. Airlines have waived their "change fees," which will result in a sizeable savings for those having to change their reserved flight in the U.S., Puerto Rico, and U.S. Virgin Islands. Effective immediately, for most Standard Economy, Economy and Premium fares on United and Delta, there will no longer be a "change fee." The downside...United Airlines will not give that partial refund, should your new flight be less that the original one. Delta states "if the new flight is cheaper, you will receive CREDIT for the price difference". Beginning January 1st, 2021, they will offer FREE (change) Same-Day Standby flights. Alaska and American are offering no change fees on some of their classes of fares. Check with your preferred airline for the most up-to-date information.

NEWS! SKI RESORTS STRUGGLE TO FILL ON-MOUNTAIN POSITIONS: Mountain and rural resorts for years have relied on a steady stream of J-1 exchange visa workers from South America, Australia and New Zealand to staff ski schools, hotels and mountain operations. However, with President Trump's June 22 executive order, that paused all foreign-worker visas to expand opportunities for American workers, the challenge of

landing seasonal workers has grown for ski areas that have long struggled to fill positions in remote — and pricey — mountain communities. Hiring enough temporary workers to fill crucial jobs has become a real challenge. Currently, college kids are filling a critical gap for resort companies that need hundreds or even thousands of seasonal workers. "Our applications from college kids are up pretty significantly over prior years. We are targeting college-age applicants, but they seem to be targeting us as well. That's a bright light in this mess," said Jim Laing, head of human resources of Aspen Skiing Company. Vail Resorts, which owns 33 ski areas in the U.S. and has historically relied on foreign workers, is recruiting more aggressively in local communities. The college students, who have more flexibility because they are learning remotely or are taking a gap year because of the pandemic, could be the answer to a lot of prayers from the ski resorts this season.
