We've received a lot of questions about the Spring Pass over the past month or so. While we have ultimately decided not to offer the Spring Pass this season, we're happy to announce that we are offering a Midweek Pass, available for purchase online!

What's the Midweek Pass? Here's what you need to know: The Midweek Pass gets you lift access to Meadows during midweek operations (Monday through Friday, 9 AM to close) starting March 1 through the end of the 2020-2021 season

- The price is \$239 for those in the 25-64 age bracket, \$219 for the 65-74 age bracket, and \$199 for the 7-24 age bracket
- We will also be offering a Midweek Pass Package that includes a Midweek Pass, three lessons, and unlimited midweek ski/snowboard rentals, valid March 1 through the rest of the season, for \$299
- Current Night Pass holders can upgrade to a Midweek Pass for \$199, and can continue to use their nighttime access (2-9 PM) on non-midweek days when we have night operations (in other words, good for access 9 AM to close Monday through Friday, and 2-9 PM on the Saturdays and Sundays that have night operations)
- We will also be offering a Spring Nordic Pass, which is valid starting March 1 for all remaining days of Nordic operations, both midweek and weekend days. The price of the Spring Nordic Pass is \$45 for adults, \$29 for youth (18 and under)
- Add-ons: all Midweek Pass holders will be able to add on Gear Check for \$19, as well as a Spring Nordic Pass for \$29

DATE CHANGED! The next **FWSA Convention** will now be held in San Diego October 7-10, 2021. For details see <u>FWSA page</u> on the NWSCC website. We can still do all the same activities that we had planned for June. The weather will be nice, and we'll be able to enjoy the sunshine and blue skies of beautiful San Diego.

This also changes the due dates for submission for awards (including the Environmental Award, Safety Award, among others), Club and Council Newsletter and Website awards, and the Charity Recognition Program to July 18, 2021. U.S. SKI AND SNOWBOARD HALL OF FAME: In mid-January, the U.S. Ski and Snowboard Hall of Fame hosted an evening with Art Clay and Ben Finley from the National Brotherhood of Skiers in a Zoom meeting. It was an enjoyable and enlightening time, listening to the stories that both Art and Ben had to tell of how the NBS got its start, and how they've grown since that day in 1973. They were to be inducted into the U.S. Ski and Snowboard Hall of Fame in 2020, but due to the COVID Pandemic, the induction ceremony had to be postponed. Once that can happen, they will be duly inducted. In 2015, at the Far West Convention in San Diego, Art Clay and Ben Finley received the *Far West Snowsports Builder Awards*. NEW ADDITIONS TO THE "INDY" PASS: Soldier Mountain and Pomerelle Mountain Resort, Idaho, have joined the Indy Pass. Each resort will provide Indy Pass holders two days of access through the end of the 2020-21 season. The pass now includes access to 16 ski areas in the Pacific Northwest, and 61 North American ski areas in all.
