FAR WEST 89TH ANNUAL CONVENTION - 4 MONTHS AWAY: The 2022 Convention is coming up in just 4 short months! WHAT IT MEANS TO BE "SSSS'D: In all of your travels over the past years, especially since Covid times, if you've ever had the bad luck of having this code appear on your boarding pass, it's TSA's way of flagging airline passengers for "enhanced" screening. An SSSS code, or Secondary Security Screening Selection overrides preapproval through a Trusted Traveler Program such as "TSA Pre-Check". Many travelers unknowingly flag themselves due to inconsistent travel behaviors such as booking a last-minute ticket or paying in cash. If you book one-way flights, or if your name bears even a passing resemblance to someone on a Department of Homeland Security watch list, it could send up a red flag. Consistency is the key when traveling. So, if you see this on your Boarding Pass, be prepared for a lengthy delay in getting onto your next flight.
