ATTENTION SKIERS: TIMBERLINE NEEDS YOUR HELP NOW (DEADLINE MAY 9, 2005)!!!

The Forest Service has released the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for Timberline's proposed "Timberline Express" chairlift and Ski Trail Network. The proposed chair is located in the lower portion of the mountain between the Pucci and Stormin' Norman chairlifts, and would provide 4 new intermediate and advanced trails that would provide protected skiing when weather conditions shut down the upper mountain. Night skiing would be expanded, as half the terrain would be lighted for night skiing. This chairlift proposal will improve guest experiences in the following ways: shorter lift lines throughout Timberline Ski Area; more

terrain available when the upper mountain closes due to inclement weather, more intermediate and advanced intermediate terrain (including tree skiing!), a better night skiing product, and less crowding during special events like ski racing and halfpipe competitions. It is extremely important for positive comments to be received from as many ski area users as possible, because it is well known that the highly organized environmental groups will flood the Forest Service with adverse comments to anything proposed by any ski area - and most of their people commenting have never set foot on Mt. Hood! The Forest Service prefers substantive comments (based on supportive data) rather than comments like "Build it and they will come." First-hand experience, and personal knowledge of the ski area, will add credibility to your comment letter. PLEASE SHOW THEM THAT SKIERS AND SNOWBOARDERS CARE ABOUT EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENT OF OUR SKI AREAS!

MAN AND WOMAN OF THE YEAR AWARDS: Sylvia Kearns will be responsible for receiving names of candidates from NWSCC's member clubs. Every club should individually choose its own Man and Woman of the Year, who may then

win the FWSA competition. Last year each participant received a 2-night trip for 2 people to Big White in Canada (transportation not included), and the FWSA winners received a number of prizes, including a trip. Our own Emilio Trampuz of Mountain High Snowsport Club was the winner of FWSA's

Man of the Year, and won a 5-day trip for two to Big White, Canada! Mary Olhausen was NWSCC's Woman of the Year for 2003, and the picture shows her and Sylvia Kearns (her invited guest) on the 2-day trip that she won!

The Convention will hold its usual fun activities (Thursday Mardi Gras Pub Crawl, Friday Golf, Tennis, Aquarium of the Pacific, The Queen Mary, and Kayaking through Alamitos Bay), as well as the Friday night Silent Auction, Saturday Travel Expo, and Awards Dinner & Dance, and Sunday Eye Opener Reception, Brunch, and FWSA Business meeting.

Hot News: Mission Ridge Ski Area Purchases Detachable Quad Lift! Despite a winter that left Northwestern ski resorts reeling financially, Mission Ridge Ski Area showed its pluck with its recent purchase of the Summit Express lift from Winter Park, CO. The detachable quad lift will replace Mission Ridge's Chair #2, and will nearly double the capacity and halve the ride time. Chair #2 serves a vast amount of terrain. including the resort's primary groomed cruisers, the B.2.4 Terrain Park, and many of its backcountry bowls and chutes. The old double chair, installed in 1966, was a primary complaint among modern skiers who expect fast lifts. Mission Ridge will also start the first phase of its snowmaking expansion this summer. Once completed, Mission Ridge will possess the most extensive snowmaking system in Washington State. The improvements were both part of the resort's 2003 Master Development Plan and will be an investment of over 2.5 million dollars.

Located well east of the Cascade crest, Mission Ridge (located just 12 miles from Wenatchee) is known for its fair weather and cold snow. no other ski hill in Washington matches its nearby amenities or its bed base. Normal winter operations run from mid-December through early April. In summer, the resort accommodates meetings, weddings, and receptions. For more information, visit www.missionridge.com.
