CLUB NEWS:

NORTHWEST SNOWSPORTS FOUNDATION will present \$8,400 in scholarships to this year's winners during the Portland Ski Show on Saturday. Two of the scholarships are donated by NWSCC members clubs Skiyente and Schnee Vogeli. The Foundation is getting ready for its silent auction fundraiser at next June's Golden Rose Ski Classic. One of the past scholarship winners, Kevin Francis, is now on the U.S. Ski Team's "B" team!

The MT. HOOD SKI PATROL is getting ready for a busy ski season, which may start sooner than expected if the current snows keep coming! Their 250-300 volunteer patrollers all undergo rigorous training, with 80 hours of classroom training, outdoor survival training, and first aid. Every spring they hold tryouts, and conduct training for the apprentice patrollers during the following year. Benefits are mostly intangible for these hard-working volunteers - they receive heartfelt respect and admiration from those they rescue and pull down the hill on sleds, and the ski areas provide lift privileges for them and their families. They also have a nordic patrol, and for those who aren't strong skiers, there are positions in the First Aid Room.

MOUNTAIN HIGH SNOWSPORT CLUB will have its annual "membership" party on November 16, 2004, at the Recreation Room at Mountain Park, Portland. Everyone is welcome! ANOTHER WIN FOR NORTHWEST SNOWSPORTS ADVOCATES! The Forest Service decision on Mt. Ashland has been received, and Mt. Ashland has been given approval to construct new base area guest service buildings, more parking spaces, a snow tubing area, and, most importantly, a new quad chairlift serving longer and easier ski runs, all within the Special Use Permit Area. The decision is certain to be appealed, and Mt. Ashland will need support from skiers. Mt. Ashland is unique among our state ski areas, as it is a nonprofit ski area owned by the City of Ashland, which took it over when former owners were in financial difficulties. Letters of support to newspapers and the Forest Service are needed. It's easy to help and your help is needed NOW! Sign up for the NW Snowsports Advocates list serve.
