We are so incredibly pleased and grateful to announce that we are officially open for the 2020-2021 season! Meadows is currently open seven days a week from 9 AM - 4 PM for your downhill, snow-sliding needs (our Nordic Center is also scheduled to operate Thursdays - Mondays from 9 AM - 4 PM). We are also grateful for the strong base produced by earlyseason storms and our snow harvesting team, which has allowed us to open with a great variety of lifts and terrain.

Before you head up for your first turns of the season, please read our blog post (link below) on current guidelines in place at the resort so you are prepared. If you're short on time, the greatest hits are:

Also, if you purchased a Season Pass, but still need to pick it up, you can swing by Meadows PDX, get your pass fulfilled, and then head straight to the lifts on your first day up!

Once again, we are so happy to be open, to see all of you, and to get back to doing what we all love. Here's to a safe and fun 2020-2021 season. READ THE BLOG AND KNOW BEFORE YOU GO! Lift tickets are now on sale for the holiday period of December 21 to January 3, as well as for the dates of December 3 and 4! Head to our Dynamic Pricing page HERE to dial in your lift ticket by selecting your access type, age range, start time, and duration, and then choose the date... or you can choose the date and see what kinds of tickets are available for that day. As we mention in the story above, please note that all lift tickets must be purchased online in advance, and there will be no day-of lift tickets available at the resort. We also have day tickets for the Nordic Center available! As we get through the first few days of the season and continue to reassess our operations, there is a possibility we will be making more dates available -- watch our website and social media channels for updates!

Programs are also now available for sale online! Our Consecutive Week Programs are a great way for kids to build their confidence and their skills on the slopes, staying with the same instructor and group once a week for four consecutive weeks. Currently, we only have programs for kids ages 7-14 (the SnoBlasters program), but we will be adding programs for older kids and adults online soon! SEASON PASS sales are closed for the winter season.

Capacity at Timberline will be managed based on how many cars our parking lot is able safely accommodate, first-come-first-served. However, our uphill ski area capacity far exceeds the number of parking spots. When the lot is at a safe operating capacity, Timberline Road will close. People will be allowed up when spaces become available. Please plan on arriving after 7:00am when the roads are plowed, but well before 9:00am to gain access before the road closes. We anticipate capacity to free up in the afternoons when people often leave after a morning of skiing.

LET'S KEEP OUR SEASON SAFE Only visit and share the chair with members of your household. Use your vehicle as a base camp. Masks and social distancing are required indoors and outdoors in ticket & lift lines. LEARN MORE

FOOD & BEVERAGE SERVICE Timberline's restaurants that will be open for takeout on opening day include the Wy'East Cafe, Phlox Point, and our new food truck! Consuming food & drink indoors is not currently permitted. LEARN MORE

TIMBERLINE HOLIDAYS Celebrating the holidays at Timberline is a fun and long-standing tradition for many. This year, the holidays will be as memorable as always, if slightly different from year's past. LEARN MORE

FULL MOON SNOWSHOE Join us for a lovely night of socially-distanced snowshoeing under the full moon. This hotel package includes a room for two, snowshoes, and the guided snowshoe walk. Available Jan. 28, Feb. 25, and March 28, 2021. Availability is limited to keep the group small, some restrictions apply.

ROOM + LIFT TICKET Stay the night midweek (Sundays-Thursdays) and get one free lift ticket to use the day after check-in. Some restrictions apply.

Last weekend we opened Day and Cosmic Tubing for the 2020.2021 with great success. For the next two weekends, we will be open for tubing on Saturdays and Sundays from 11am to 8:15pm. Be sure to make reservations for days HERE or Cosmic Tubing HERE as space is limited.

On to the big question.....when are we opening for skiing and riding? We are SO close! We've been out prepping the hill and track packing the surface all week. The forecast is calling for a few days of unseasonably warm temperatures with some wet precip scheduled over the weekend with snow forecasted for Tuesday evening into Wednesday. Given the fact our base is very loose (unfrozen/sugar) we feel it is in the best interest for long-term surface conditions to delay operations until this weather cycle passes. That said, we are targeting opening for next Wednesday, December 9th at 3pm. Stay tuned to our website for updates as we move closer to opening day.

After much consideration, discussion and listening, we, too, have made the decision to not to require advanced reservations for pass holders. That's right, NO RESERVATIONS REQUIRED! We've learned much from areas already open and heard from our pass holders and just feel it would not be the best way to move ahead. Daily volume will be managed on a first-come, first-served basis using parking capacity as the main gauge for volume management, including day ticket sales and rentals.

Unplug. Unwind. Recharge - We now offer two lodging properties that make it easy for you to STAY AND PLAY. Choose from either Collins Lake with luxury condos, or Lake Simtustus Resort with luxury tiny home rentals, RV rentals, RV campsites, and marina and moorage slips. WHO & WHAT'S NEW FOR 2020

"NEWS"! ON YOUR MARK! GET SET! SKI!: Mammoth is open! Sun Peaks is open! So are several Colorado ski areas (Aspen Mountain, Breckenridge, and Keystone). With the current pandemic, please take heed and "Know Before You Go," long a backcountry mantra that will apply to all skiers and riders this year. Guests should visit ski area websites, social media and other channels to ensure they have the most up-to-date information on any COVID-19 protocols and understand what is expected during their visit. Colorado Ski Country's COVID-19 webpage will be updated throughout the winter with tips, information and the most up-to-date resort protocols.

Many ski areas will be requiring prepurchase of lift tickets, ski school reservations, rentals and other activities and guests should check with the ski area they plan to visit before and leading up to their arrival. Ski parties will be allowed to load lifts and gondolas together at full capacity. Parties that are not together will have at least one seat between them on lifts. Up to two unrelated parties can load a gondola together up to 50 percent capacity. Parties that are uncomfortable riding with other parties will be allowed to ride as a single party. Again, check the website of the ski area you are planning to visit so that you "know before you go"!

"NEWS"! TELLURIDE SKI RESORT: Telluride will welcome NEW air service this winter with Southwest Airlines and Jet Blue adding flights into Montrose Regional Airport (MJT) starting in mid-December. Southwest will fly 2-3 times daily from Denver (DEN) and Saturdays and Sundays from Dallas Love Field (DAL). Jet Blue will operate from Boston Logan Airport (BOS) on Saturdays and select Wednesdays during the season. For additional information, visit www.tellurideskiresort.com. Telluride resort will feature 20 refurbished gondolas offering dining options in Mountain Village as well as expanded yurt and outdoor dining services across the mountain.
